



James "Dean" Allred

Seabrook – James “Dean” Allred, 79, of Seabrook, passed away at his home on Sunday, November 16, 2025. Dean was born in Tooele, Utah, on October 4, 1946, to the late Marlin and Edna (Murray) Allred.

Dean leaves behind his wife of 41 years, Nancy (Witham) Allred, of Seabrook; his children, B. Lisa Allred-Finn and Rachel Allred-Nighan, both of Florida; his siblings, Richard Allred, Mark Allred, Lorraine Gallant and Lois Brooks. He was predeceased by his youngest brother, John Allred. He also leaves behind his sister-in-law, Sally A. Witham, of Saco, Maine.

Dean grew up in Rowley, MA and he graduated from Newburyport High School in 1964. Following his graduation he honorably served his country in the United States Air Force for four years. It was there he learned the HVAC skills that shaped his life long career. In 1978 Dean went to work for Munters Corporation (formerly Cargocaire Engineering) in Amesbury, MA. For several years he traveled nationally and internationally performing field service work. He retired in 2015.

In his spare time Dean enjoyed building and flying radio controlled model airplanes. For many years he was a member of two local clubs – the Northeast RC Model Club in Salisbury, MA and the RC Aces in North Hampton, NH. He served as President of the RC Aces for several years and

always enjoyed training anyone who was new to the hobby. In later years he also became the unofficial “go to” auctioneer for both clubs. For 38 years Dean was also a member of Saint Mark’s Lodge in Newburyport, MA.
