Hampton – James J. Djerf, 94, of Hampton, passed away with his family by his side on Thursday, March 20, 2025, at the Edgewood Nursing Home in Portsmouth, NH.

He was born February 1, 1931 in Amesbury, MA the son of the late Jacob and Bertha (Makela) Djerf, who were immigrants from Finland. Raised in Amesbury, he graduated from Amesbury High School with the Class of 1949 (the “49ers”). He went on to proudly serve 4 years in the United States Air Force as an aircraft mechanic.

After his time in the service, James returned home and started his career as a civil service aircraft mechanic at the former Pease Air Force Base in Portsmouth until his retirement in 1985.

A longtime Hampton Falls First Baptist Church member he was also a member of the Hamptons American Legion Post 35 and Saint James Lodge #102 F. & A.M. He enjoyed woodworking and was a jack of all trades and who could fix anything. A snowbird for 14 years, he enjoyed wintering in Kissimmee, FL with his late wife Laura (Rose) Djerf who predeceased him in 2006.

In addition to his parents and wife, he was predeceased by his daughter Cindy Jones of Hampton and sister Evelyn Nelson of Belfast, ME.

Surviving family members include his daughters and son in laws, Steph Harmon and her husband Bob of Beaumont, CA, Pam Provencher and her husband Gary of Hampton and Pat Wakeman and her husband Ken of Barrington, NH and Alan Jones of Hampton.
