Hampton Beach – James A. “Jim” Duhamel, 53, of Hampton Beach, died on Saturday, October 17, 2015 at the Rockingham County Nursing Home in Brentwood after a period of failing health.

Jim was born on February 10, 1962 in Woonsocket, RI, a son of Come Duhamel of Woonsocket and the late Shirley (Allard) Duhamel.

Jim was raised in Woonsocket and had summered at Hampton Beach as a youth. 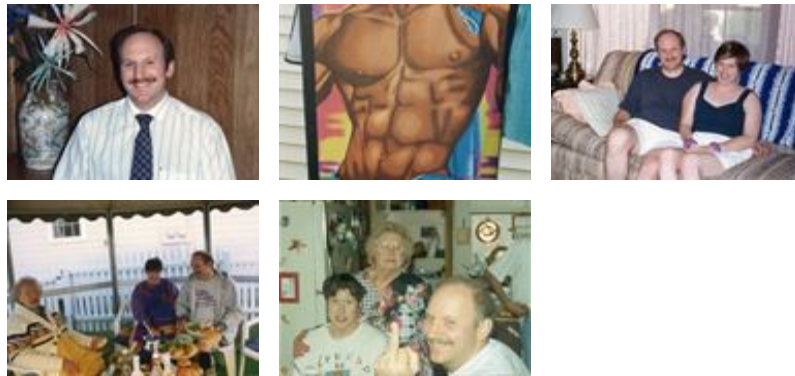
