



Jaqueline Reynolds Mahoney

North Hampton - Jaqueline Reynolds Mahoney, of North Hampton, NH, formerly of Lowell, MA, passed away peacefully on September 23, 2023, at the age of 96. She was the beloved wife of David F. Mahoney for 42 years, who predeceased her in 2001.

Jaqueline was born in 1927 in Lowell, Massachusetts, to James and Agnes Reynolds. She graduated from Lowell High School, where she served as First Lieutenant in the Girls Officer's Battalion and was named to the National Honor Society. Jaqueline went on to study at Trinity College in Washington, D.C.

Jaqueline was a kind, thoughtful and caring woman who defined grace and humility. She was a loyal friend, adored and respected by all who knew her. She was a committed tennis player for many years. She devoted her free time to volunteering for Families First. She loved to play golf and dine at Abeniqui Country Club. She particularly enjoyed hosting family gatherings at the holidays and the annual Connemara Open at her home in North Hampton. For many years she was a parishioner of Our Lady of the Immaculate Medal in Hampton, and then later of Saint Theresa Parish in Rye Beach, NH. She was the daughter of James and Agnes Reynolds of Lowell, MA and was predeceased by her siblings Jack Reynolds, Brian Reynolds, Dick Reynolds, Patricia Cawley and James Reynolds.

She married David F. Mahoney in 1959 and initially lived in Boston before settling in North Hampton in 1961 to raise their family. Theirs was a devoted and loving partnership. They loved travelling the world together, especially the great cities of Europe.

She is survived by her daughters, Kathleen Mahoney and her husband Ozzie Ayscue of New Castle, NH; Colleen Mahoney and her husband Jack Reid of Rye, NH and her son, Sean Mahoney and his wife, Kirsten Mahoney of Portsmouth, NH. She is pre-deceased by her son, David and daughter, Erin. Nothing brought her greater joy and pride than spending time with her six grandsons, Christian, David and Will Ayscue, and Jack, Luke, and James Mahoney.
