



Jarib M. "Ted" Sanderson Jr.

August 11, 1934 - December 27, 2014

North Hampton – Jarib M. “Ted” Sanderson, Jr. 80, formerly of Greenland and a longtime resident of North Hampton, died Saturday, December 27, 2014 after an extended illness. He was surrounded by his loving family.

Ted was born on August 11, 1934 in Portsmouth, the son of the late L. Gwendolyn (Woods) and Jarib M. Sanderson, Sr.

It was while growing up in Greenland that his love for farming, flying and family was nurtured and cultivated. After graduating from Portsmouth High School with the Class of 1952, Ted did a brief stint in the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard apprenticeship program before being accepted into the Air National Guard, Air Force Cadet Program. After earning his wings in 1956 at Bryan AFB, Bryan, TX, Ted shipped off to Williams Air Force base in Mesa, AZ. It was there that he took command of his first F-86 Sabrejet. Ted described flying as “the ultimate freedom. “ He was able to parlay his love of flying when he joined Eastern Airlines in 1957. He remained with the Air National Guard and was called to active duty during the Vietnam conflict in 1961-1962 and again in 1963, when Ted was commissioned to fly, then New Hampshire Governor John King, to Andrews Air Force Base to attend the funeral for President Kennedy. Ted retired from the service in 1968 as a Captain. He remained with Eastern until the company folded in 1991, proudly retiring as a 34 year veteran having earned the rank as Check Captain.

Besides flying, Ted was a life-long farmer and could often be found mowing his fields and tending his land at Sanderson's farm in Greenland. He never wavered at sharing his farm with those that sought a peaceful retreat.

Whether for a group of disadvantaged children for their annual fishing derby or hosting the annual Sanderson Ultra-Light fly-in, Ted never turned anyone down and was often found proudly standing on the sidelines watching the events. Ted's greatest love, however, was reserved for his family.

He will be greatly missed by his wife Suzanne (Wilder), of North Hampton; his sons, Doug and his wife, Mary Sue of Hampton and David and his wife Amy of Kensington; his daughter, Julee Sanderson and her husband James McClure of Kensington; his seven grandchildren, Megan Van Roie and her husband Justin of Arlington, VA, Adam Sanderson, Skylar McClure, Shane McClure, Lauren Sanderson, Rachel Sanderson and Jarib Sanderson. He also leaves his niece Candace Potter and many close friends.

Family and friends may visit from 6.00 to 8.00 PM on Monday, December 29, 2014 in the Remick and Gendron Funeral Home, 811 Lafayette Rd., Hampton. Services will be held on Tuesday at 1:00 PM in the Greenland Congregational Church, 10 Post Road, Greenland. Burial will be in the Prospect Hill Cemetery, Greenland.
