



## Jean Woodburn

May 11, 1933 - February 21, 2018

Hampton – Jean Woodburn, 84, a longtime resident of Hampton, passed away peacefully at her home on Wednesday, February 21, 2018, surrounded by her family.

Jean was born in Boston, MA on May 11, 1933 to the late Norman and Christine (MacKenzie) Thistle. She was raised in Jamaica Plain and met her future husband, John F. Woodburn, after he returned from United States Air Force. They were married in 1955 and relocated to Hampton Falls for a short time before purchasing their current home in Hampton in 1958. Jean worked as a secretary for Winnacunnet High School for many years until her retirement in 1990. She was a hard working woman, although, caring for her family was her greatest joy.
