



Jeffry C. Frampton

September 27, 1949 - June 3, 2013

North Hampton – Jeffry C. Frampton, 63, of North Hampton, formerly of Portsmouth, New Castle and Newfields, died Monday, June 3, 2013 at home with loving family by his bedside.

He was born in Baltimore, MD, September 27, 1949, a son of Eunice Frampton of New Castle and the late Harold V. Frampton.

Jeff was raised in New Castle and graduated from Portsmouth High School with the Class of 1968. After school he entered the U.S. Army and served his country honorably during the Vietnam War. He was awarded two Purple Heart Medals for injuries received during the war. Jeff went to work for the Portsmouth Post Office upon his discharge from the Army and then went to work for the NH Department of Transportation until his retirement in 2012. He served as a selectman for the Town of Newfields and was a Life Member of the Disabled American Veterans, Squamscott Chapter 13 of Exeter. Jeff loved hunting, fishing and his camp in Lincoln, ME. He lived for his children and grandchildren. He will be missed by many and never forgotten.

In addition to his mother, he is survived by his son, David A. Frampton of North Hampton; his daughters, Jennifer A. Frampton of North Hampton, Lindsay M. Wilson of Dover and Jennifer J. Wilson of Stratham; his sister Linda Fernald and her husband Michael of North Berwick, ME; his

grandchildren, Molly Sturtevant and Leah Wilson; his sister-in-law Alice Frampton of Florida and his former wives Antoinette Talienti of North Hampton and Carol McGrady of Stratham.

He was predeceased by his father Harold Frampton and his brothers Damon and Michael Frampton.
