



## Jeremiah McSweeney

Hampton Falls – Jeremiah McSweeney, 87, of Hampton Falls, passed away peacefully on Monday, May 13, 2019 at Exeter Hospital with family by his side.

He was born in Cork City, Ireland on April 30, 1932, a son of the late John and Ellen (Mulcahy) McSweeney.

Raised in Cork City, he graduated from South Presentation Monastery School and in 1950 Jeremiah moved to the states for better opportunities, where he was drafted by the Army and proudly served during the Korean War.

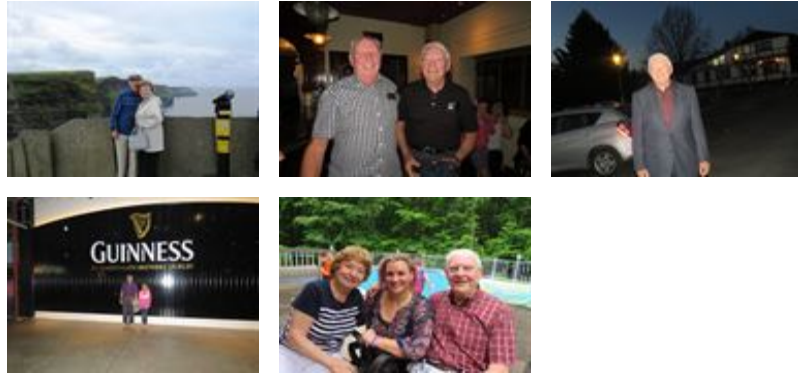
