Hampton – Joan Brown, 89, of Hampton, died Friday June 13, 2014 at her home.

She was born in Boston, Mass., August 15, 1924 the daughter of the late Stanley R. and Laura (Dixon) Thurber. Raised in Boston she was a graduate of St. Mary's High School in Cambridge, Mass.
