Stratham – John W. Chalpin, DMD, 74, of Stratham, passed away peacefully on Sunday, July 17, 2022.

He was born March 9, 1948 in Boston, MA a son of the late John F. and Florence (Baclawski) Chalpin. Raised in Boston, he graduated Boston College High School at the age of 16. He went on to graduate from Boston College and Tufts School of Dentistry.

He was also an avid reader who enjoyed fine dining, collecting menus autographed by chefs and recreating restaurant fare at home with a glass of “cooking wine” in hand. He enjoyed vacationing on Maui where he and his wife, Patricia were married at sunset, deep sea fishing, boating and photography.
