



## John T. Costello Jr.

November 24, 1931 - August 21, 2013

Seabrook Beach, NH – John T. Costello, Jr. 81, died Wednesday, August 21, 2013 at the Exeter Hospital following a five year battle with Alzheimer's.

He was born in Haverhill, MA on November 24, 1931, the son of the late John T. and May (Keefe) Costello. He was a 1950 graduate of Haverhill High School and a graduate of Northeastern University, receiving a doctorate in psychology.

Mr. Costello was a Korean War veteran serving with the US Navy. He was a psychologist working for several area schools and hospitals.

He resided many years in Seabrook Beach coming from Lawrence, MA and wintered for several years in Naples' FL and Arizona.

Family members include his wife, Clare (Dineen) Costello of Seabrook Beach; a son, John J. Costello of Redwood Shores, CA; a granddaughter, Emily Costello; a brother, James Costello and his wife, Elaine of Lawrence, MA; a sister, Joan M.
