Seabrook – John T. Farrell, 78, of Seabrook, passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on Monday, August 26, 2019.

John was born on July 19, 1941 in Chicago, IL, a son of the late Carl and Margaret (Stocking) Farrell. He was a lifelong resident of Medina, NY and earned his under graduate degree from Ithaca College in Oswego, NY. John taught high school Physical Education in Oswego where he also coached soccer and swimming with some of his swimmers going on to compete in the Olympics. 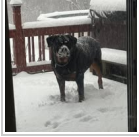
