Greenland - John J. Veneski, 64, of Greenland, NH, formerly of Shamokin, PA passed away Wednesday, September 18, 2019 in Dover. John was a cancer survivor since 1988. He was born in Shamokin on January 3, 1955. He was one of seven children to Martin Veneski and the late Christine (Senoski) Veneski both of Shamokin.

John was raised in Shamokin. He graduated from Our Lady of Lourdes Regional High School in Coal Township, PA with the class of 1972. He received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Information Processing from Bloomsburg University, Bloomsburg, PA in 1979.

John was a veteran serving with the US Air Force attaining the rank of Captain. He worked for the Air Force System Command at Hanscom Air Force Base in Bedford, MA and Langley Air Force Base in Hampton, VA as a Systems Development Officer. He received his Master of Business Administration Degree from Golden Gate University, San Francisco, CA while serving in the US Air Force and was honorably discharged in 1984.

He was employed as an IT Specialist at Spruce Environmental Technologies, Inc. in Ward Hill, MA for 17 years. He enjoyed spending time with family, bicycling, hiking, camping, was an avid downhill skier, and a published poet and photographer.

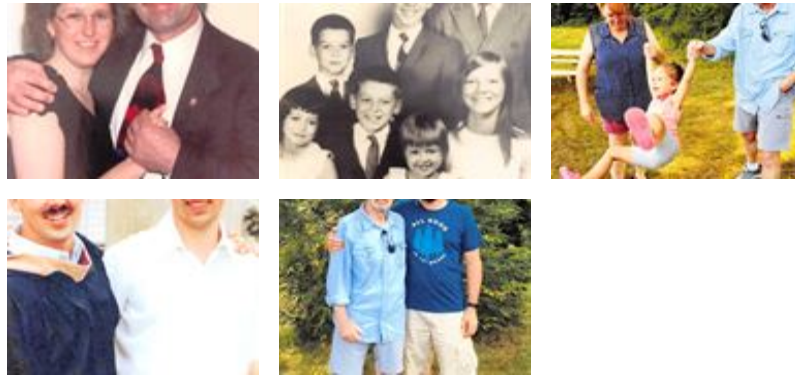


