Hampton – John H. White, 75, of Hampton and Myrtle Beach, SC, formerly of Windham, passed away peacefully on Friday, March 15, 2019.

He was born in Methuen, MA on September 15, 1943, a son of the late Joseph M. and Esther (Lahey) White.

Raised in Lawrence, MA he graduated from Lawrence High School with the Class of 1961 and later attended Rittners School of Floral Design in Boston

John enlisted in the United States Marine Corps Reserve in 1964 and served until 1991, reaching the rank of Chief Warrant Officer (CWO-4). During this time he also had a successful career as an ironworker, working over 30 years with Ironworkers Local 7 out of Boston, MA.

Family was very important to him and his grandchildren were his pride and joy. He enjoyed helping people in any way he could. In his spare time, he would golf, enjoy the sunshine and always loved a good game of cribbage.

He shared 45 years of marriage with his late wife Nancy (Batchelder) White who predeceased him in 2010.

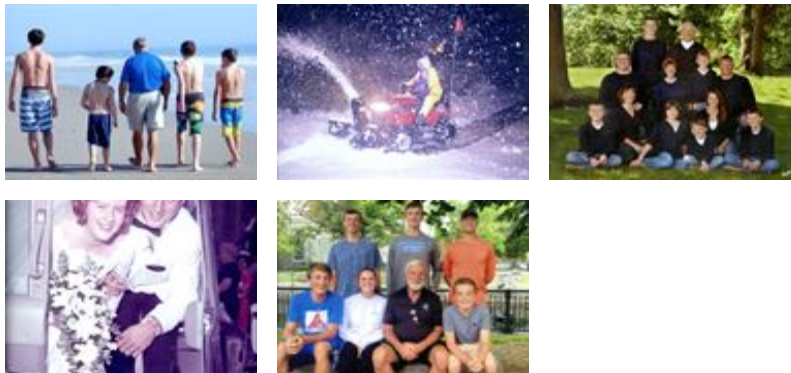
