Hampton – Joseph F. Calvani, 80, of Hampton, a former 40 year resident of Marblehead, MA, died peacefully on Tuesday, September 6, 2016 at Clipper Harbor in Portsmouth.

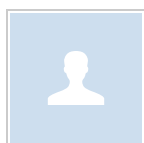
