Seabrook Beach – Joseph D. R. “Dick” Boucher, 87, of Seabrook Beach, died Monday, September 13, 2021 at his home surrounded by his family. He was born in Lawrence, MA June 22, 1934 the son of the late Joseph Boucher and Florence (L’Heureux) Boucher LaPlume.

Dick was raised in Lawrence and graduated from Central Catholic High School in Lawrence and then enlisted with the US Coast Guard serving from 1952-1956 aboard the US Coast Guard Cutter Duane.

He had a long career in computer technology working in quality assurance and as a mechanical technician in building some of the first computers. 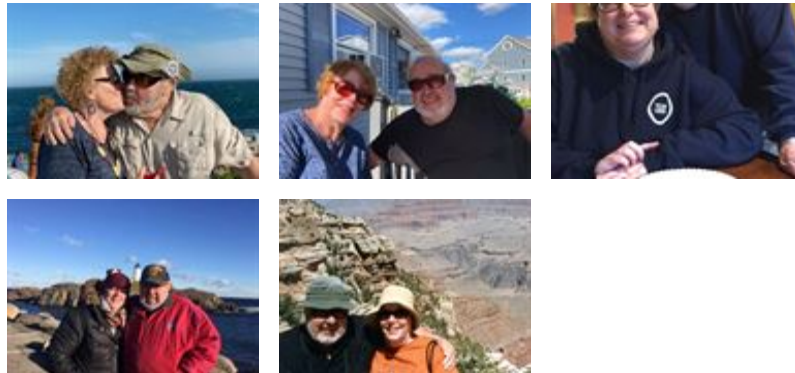
