



## Joseph A. Hammond

February 3, 1926 - December 19, 2016

North Hampton - Joseph A. Hammond, 90, of North Hampton died December 19, 2016 at the Hyder Family Hospice House in Dover.

He was born in Kittery, Maine, February 3, 1926 a son of the late John and Harriet (Carew) Hammond.

Joe was a veteran of WW II serving with the 5th Division of the US Marine Corps. He participated in action against the Japanese on Iwo Jima and in the occupation of Japan.

After the war he was employed in construction and in 1947 he founded J.A. Hammond Dry Wall and Plaster. He ran a successful company for many years.

He was one of the founding members of the Hampton Rod and Gun Club and was an avid trap shooter winning many awards locally and nationally.

He was the husband of the late Rhoda J. (Danis) Hammond who predeceased him in 1996.

He leaves two sons, Joseph W. Hammond of Frehold, NJ, Paul Farrell of Hampton, two grandsons, Charles Farrell of Tuftonboro and Shawn Farrell of

Rollinsford, two granddaughters, Margo and Sofia Farrell.
