



## Joseph T. Jaquez

August 27, 1932 - November 11, 2021

Rye – Joseph T. Jaquez, 89, of Rye, died Thursday, November 11, 2021 at Wentworth Douglass Hospital in Dover with family by his side. He leaves his wife Marie (Cannon) Jaquez with whom he shared 35 years of marriage. He was born August 27, 1932 in Blanco, New Mexico a son of the late Edulijere and Amalia (Munoz) Jaquez.

He graduated from high school in Sanford, CO in 1950 then soon enlisted in the military serving in the Korean War with the US Navy for nearly four years and later with the US Army for three years receiving his honorable discharge in 1957. He graduated from Worcester, MA Junior College in 1959.

Joe spent his working life as a sales representative securing freight transportation contracts for the trucking industry. He retired in 1997 and enjoyed his retired life completely, playing golf and occasionally enjoyed wagering on race horses. Joe was a friend of Bill W. for 46 years and he helped many men recover from addiction. "Joe was a man of strong faith and was honored to serve as a Eucharistic Minister for many years. He was a devoted fan of all New England sports. Joe also was an avid reader; frequently visiting his local library."

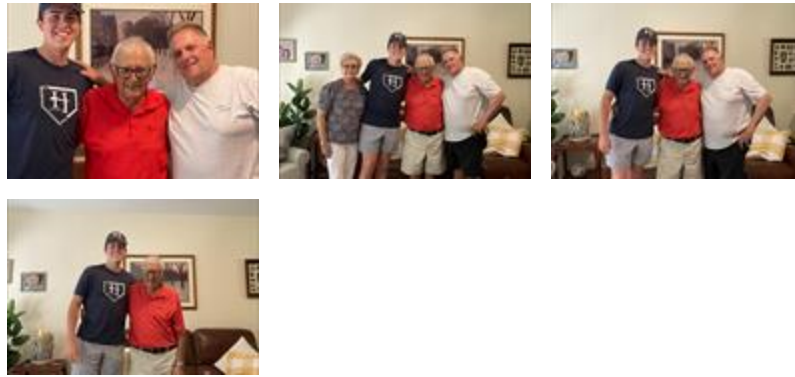
