



## Joseph M. Jones

September 10, 1951 - June 30, 2022

Fremont, NH – Joseph M. Jones, 70, of Fremont and a former longtime resident of Seabrook, NH, passed away peacefully on Thursday, June 30, 2022 at his home surrounded by devoted and caring family. He was born in Camden, NJ on September 10, 1951, a son of the late Robert L. and Patricia (Haley) Jones.

Joseph was raised in Seabrook, NH, where he spent the majority of his life. He graduated from Winnacunnet High School, attended Virginia Polytechnic Institute and graduated from UNH Summa Cum Laude with his degree in business.

Mr. Jones worked in the financial services business for over forty years as a registered representative and consultant to several local banks in the Seacoast area of NH and MA. He also traveled the country as a national training consultant to a subsidiary of AllState based in Salt Lake City Utah. During his career he spent fifteen years with Metropolitan Life Insurance Company in sales and management, was owner of Jones Financial Network, and worked with Trust Advisory Group in Waltham MA as a representative, shareholder and board of directors' member. He held the designations of Chartered Financial Consultant and Chartered Life Underwriter awarded by the American College of Financial Services.

Joseph was active in the Seabrook community having at one time been a volunteer fireman, Cubmaster, Scoutmaster, Chairman of the Board for Seabrook Boy Scouts of America and a member of the planning board serving as chairman from 1994 through 1996. He was a member of the Coast Guard Auxiliary and held a civilian Captain's license.

He was an avid boater, outdoorsman, and stock car owner, designer, and member of many race teams racing from New York to Florida. He was a Master Mason with the St. James Lodge #102 F. & A. M. of Hampton and a 32nd degree Scottish Rites member. He also contributed time by volunteering at the Lynn Shelter. In recent years Joe enjoyed traveling throughout the USA and parts of Europe. Joe loved to camp and spend time with his family and friends.

Left to cherish his memory are his beloved wife, Donna Jones, of Medford, MA; his daughter Tammy Noury and her husband Philip; grandson Andre Noury and granddaughter Alanna Noury of Epping; stepson Dante Egan of Wesley Chapel, FL and his sister, Jewel Jones and her wife Heather Davis. He was a proud friend of Bill W.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his former wife Lola Jones, his son Joseph M Jones II and his sister, Bonnie Dumas.
