Alexandria, Virginia – Joseph F. McNally, 93, of Alexandria, Virginia and former longtime resident of Hampton, New Hampshire, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, July 4, 2018 at Sunrise Assisted Living.

He was born in Lawrence, Massachusetts on March 24, 1925 a son of the late James R. McNally and Yvonne R. (Landry) McNally.

Raised in Lawrence he graduated from Central High School with the Class of 1944 and went on to graduate from Boston College in 1948 and remained a lifelong BC Eagles fan.

Mr. McNally was the district manager for Cook United which took him and his family to South Hadley, Massachusetts and Catonsville, Maryland. He retired and then relocated back to Hampton, NH where he had spent many happy summers with his family.

He shared 52 years of a wonderful marriage with his late wife Rita J. (Powers) McNally who predeceased him in 2005. After retirement they enjoyed golf, friends, sports, news, reading and traveled extensively through the US in their motorhome including visiting children and grandchildren in Florida and Virginia. A super Red Sox fan he watched every inning of every game and lived to see them win three World Series.

Surviving family members include his children, Jo-Ann McNally Muir of Alexandria, Virginia and James McNally of Miami, Florida; sister, Jean McNally Hart of Windham, NH and 6 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents and wife he was predeceased by his brothers, Fr. James McNally, OSA and John McNally.
