



Joseph J. Musumarra

September 5, 1943 - March 13, 2024

Hampton – Joseph John Musumarra, 80, of Hampton, formerly of Methuen, MA, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by his family on Wednesday March 13, 2024. He was born in Lawrence, MA on September 5, 1943 the son of the late John P. and Anne (Contarino) Musumarra.

Joseph was raised in North Andover Ma, and graduated from Central Catholic High School in Lawrence with the Class of 1961. He went on to graduate from Villanova University in 1965 and then Penn State in 1966 with his MBA.

He met his wife of 52 years on a blind date, the late Joan M. (Barry) Musumarra. They maintained a long-distance relationship when he was drafted into the army. He travelled home on a brief leave for their wedding and shortly after, they returned together to Germany where he completed his military career.

A proud entrepreneur, he owned and operated Malco Electronics with his father in Lawrence for over 40 years. His bond with his father was profound and he took great joy in being able to work every day with his best friend. Joseph proudly raised his children on their family farm in Methuen, Ma. He

owned several racehorses and loved spending time at the former Rockingham Park. He was an avid golfer, master joke teller and connoisseur of Italian pastries. A true family man, he loved spending time with his wife and kids, both on the farm in Methuen and at the beach in Hampton. He was a communicant of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal Church in Hampton and former longtime communicant of St. Monica Parish in Methuen.

Joseph is predeceased by his parents, his wife, Joan and daughter, Tara Burkhart. He leaves five children, John Musumarra and wife Jessica of Methuen, Erin Shanaver and husband Shawn of Hampton, Shallana and Kendra Musumarra both of Gardner, MA, Trae Musumarra and wife Alexis of Laconia NH; son in law, Philip Burkhart of Danville; fourteen grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.

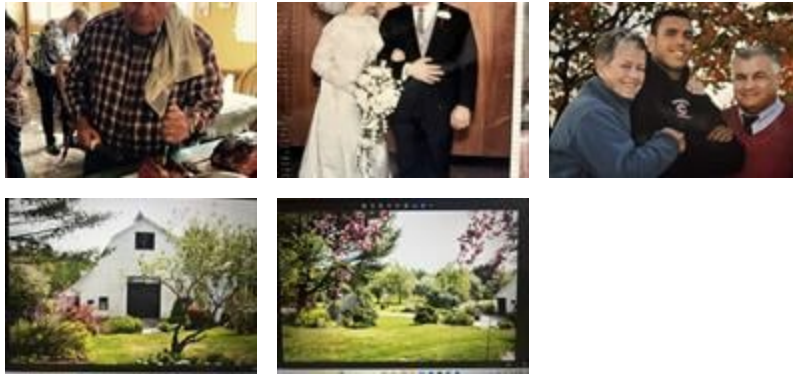

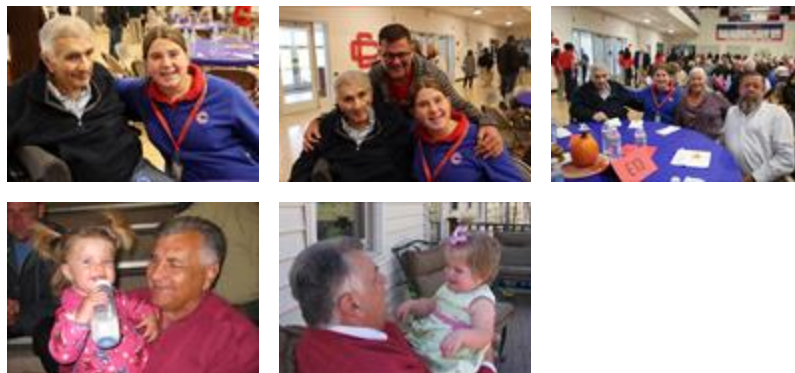
