Litchfield – Joseph S. Noble, III, 58, of Litchfield, formerly of Seabrook, died suddenly on Tuesday, April 14, 2015 at the Catholic Medical Center in Manchester.

He was born March 5, 1957 in Exeter, a son of MaryAnn Noble Newcity of Newburyport, MA and the late Joseph S. Noble, Jr.

Joe was raised in Hampton and graduated from Winnacunnet High School with the Class of 1975. He loved playing golf, fishing and target shooting.
