Tampa, FL – Joshua M. Lambert, 35, of Tampa FL, formerly of Seabrook Beach, NH, passed away on February 15th 2021 after an arduous battle with lymphoma. He was a beloved and devoted son, grandson, brother, nephew, cousin and friend.

He was born in Winchester, MA on April 5, 1985, the adored son of Kevin and Susan (Wilson) Lambert of Seabrook, NH.

Josh attended Winnacunnet High School and later St. Petersburg College. He owned a business in the home watch industry and worked as a project manager for a real estate development company.

Josh loved to travel. He was an enthusiast of life, ethnic food, music and the sea. He loved New England sports, especially the Red Sox, but spending time with his family was his greatest passion. Josh had a business mind and a caring heart. He also had a successful landscape business as a teen and doted on his elderly clients. From the very beginning of his life, he was the person who could truly accomplish anything he put his mind to. be immensely missed.

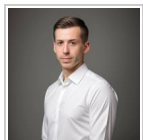
