North Hampton – Joyce M. Daly, 64, of North Hampton and Thornton, NH, passed away on Wednesday, February 15, 2017 at the Portsmouth Regional Hospital surrounded by her loving family.

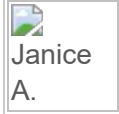

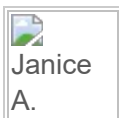
