Rye – Joyce Ann White, 85, of Hampton, passed away peacefully on Monday, January 18, 2021 at Webster at Rye where she had been living since becoming ill. 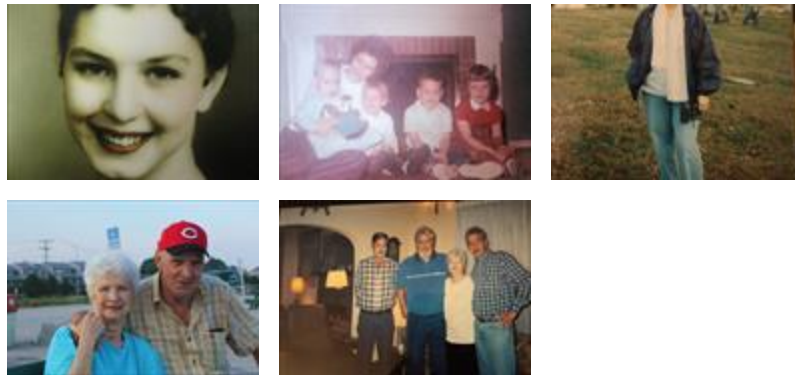
