Hampton – Judith Woodworth “Judy” Bergeron, 73, of Hampton, died Thursday, October 2, 2014 at her home.

Judy was born February 28, 1941, in Concord, Mass., a daughter of the late John W. and Gene (Atwood) Woodworth.

Her family moved to Hampton from Concord, Mass. in 1959 where Judy and her twin sister, Jean, were members of the first graduating class from Winnacunnet High School. 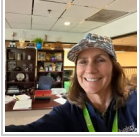
