Hampton – Judith E. “Judy” Moskevich, 83, of Hampton, formerly of Portsmouth, died Sunday, March 27, 2022 at Portsmouth Regional Hospital after a period of failing health with family by her side. She was born in Peabody, MA, May 21, 1938 the daughter of the late Frank and Georgia (Coombs) Reily.

Judy was raised in Peabody and graduated from Peabody High School with the Class of 1955. She later attended Mount Ida College in Newton, MA. She was employed for a brief time at General Electric in Lynn, MA and after her marriage to Nicholas Moskevich, Jr. on November 2, 1958 they began raising their family together.

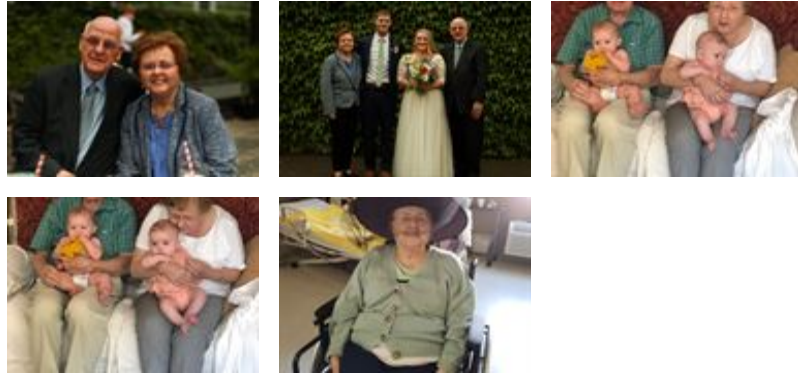
