Julie loved to travel, including to Scandinavia, Italy, and Ireland. She was a proud Red Sox and Celtics fan, rarely missing a game. She also found joy in the little things, an avid walker who logged five miles a day for more than 20 years, and a savvy shopper known for sniffing out the best deals at Filene's Basement.

Julie was also a wonderful dancer—she taught her siblings to Jitterbug and never missed a chance to hit the dance floor. Her sense of humor was legendary, and she often signed off with a mischievous smile and her favorite phrase: “Be good... and if you can't be good, be good at it.”

Above all, Julie was generous, joyful, and endlessly devoted to her family. Her warmth, wit, and wisdom leave a lasting legacy.
