She was predeceased by her maternal grandparents Wayne and Eileen Ewald.

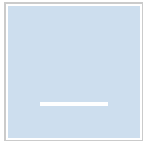

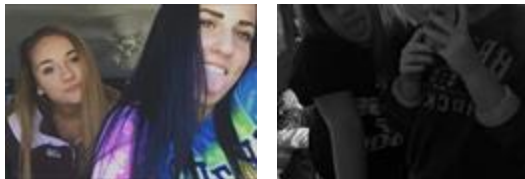

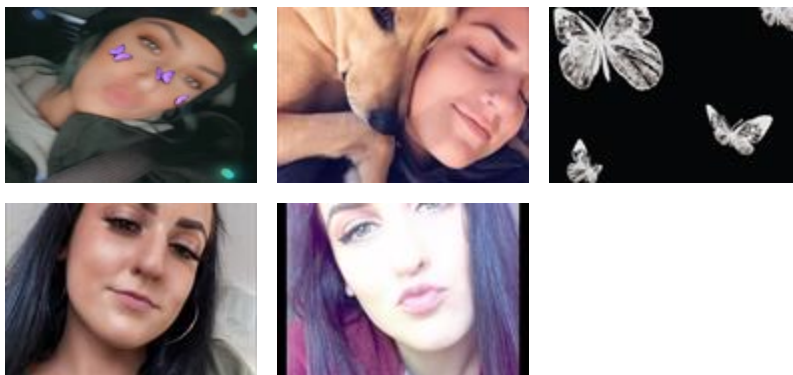
