Seabrook- Justin D. Janvrin, 26, of Seabrook, NH passed away suddenly on Saturday, June 3, 2023. He was born in Newburyport, MA on October 17, 1996, son of Jason A. Janvrin and the late Rebecca L. (Daniel) Driscoll.
