Rye, NH – K. Jeanne McMahon, 91, of Rye, passed away peacefully Monday, May 26, 2014, at Webster at Rye.

She was born in Thompsonville, CT., June 7, 1922 a daughter of the late Charles H. and Kathryn (Shea) Sheridan. Raised in Thompsonville, Jeanne graduated from Windsor Locks High School with the Class of 1940.

Jeanne married her late husband of 46 years James N. McMahon in 1944 and moved to Rye, where they made their home for the next 57 years.

She first worked as a night switchboard operator at the Wentworth by the Sea Hotel in New Castle and later at the Portsmouth Hospital. Jeanne then started her career as a bookkeeper for Tony's Radio and TV in Portsmouth, before retiring in June 1987 after 20 years.
