Seabrook – Katherine Lillian Dow, 94, of Seabrook, passed away peacefully on Thursday, September 10, 2015 at Anna Jaques Hospital. She was surrounded by loving family.

She was born March 3, 1921 in Seabrook, a daughter of the late William and Esther (Redmond) Davis.

Mrs. Dow was a life-long resident of Seabrook and had resided at Maplewood Care and Rehabilitation Center of Amesbury, MA because of failing health. Katherine had worked for New England Wood Heel of Amesbury, WELPRO of Seabrook, and CBS Hytron of Newburyport and was an excellent baker, making and selling wedding cakes out of her home.

Above all else Katherine was a homemaker and taking care of her family was the most important part of her life. She had been a member of the PTA, a Brownie Leader and a founding member of the Seabrook Historical Society. She was a very patriotic woman who gave generously to many of the armed forces charities.

She shared 41 years of marriage with her late husband, George P. Dow who predeceased her in 1982.

Family members include her son, George Dow and his wife Charleen of Seabrook, her daughters, Esther Dow and her life partner, Michael Dow of Seabrook and Mary Lou Ayers and her husband Richard, also of Seabrook and her nieces and nephews.

She was predeceased by her brother William Davis and her sisters Florence Mary Follansbee and Mabel Katherine Davis.
