Stratham – Kathy M. (Nerney) Brown, 59, of Stratham, passed peacefully Monday, September 14, 2020 at her home surrounded by family and friends after a two-year battle with ovarian cancer. She was born November 22, 1960 in Lawrence, Massachusetts.

Katie was raised in South Lawrence and graduated from Amesbury, MA High School with the Class of 1978. She was employed as a medical office assistant in the chiropractic field for over 20 years and for the past few years served as the office administrator for the Stratham Community Church.

But for Katie, family was most important. She spent years as a stay-at-home Mom raising her daughters. Her greatest joy was becoming a “Gigi” in 2019 to her grandson Ciaran, who she also cared for out of her home.

Katie made her home in Stratham in 1991 with her husband, Tim of 36 years. She was a member of the Stratham Community Church, an avid reader, and fiercely loyal friend to many.

In addition to her husband, Timothy K. Brown, she leaves two daughters Keri O’Shea and her husband John O’Shea of Stratham, Taylor Broom and her husband Christopher Broom, Jr. of North Hampton, her grandson Ciaran O’Shea, as well as several nieces and nephews.

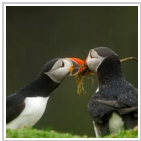
