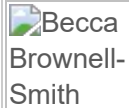

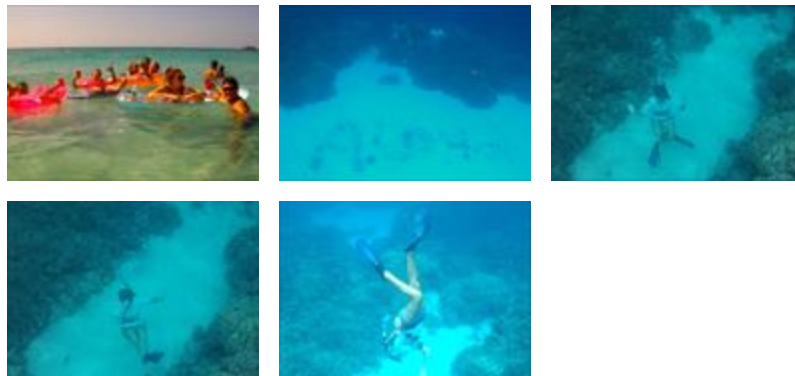
I have to say I am truly sorry for her friends and familys loss. I wish I had been really paying attention to god.
