Hampton - Kelley Ayn Serpis, 21, passed away peacefully of an undiagnosed heart condition at Massachusetts General Hospital on Saturday, May 20, 2017. 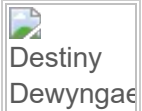

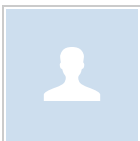
