Rye – Kenneth I. “Skip” Gaucher, 64, of Rye, died Saturday, April 26, 2014 at his home surrounded by his family.

He was born May 26, 1949 in Newburyport, MA a son of the late Kenneth E. and Lorraine May (Fowler) Gaucher.

Skip spent his childhood in Rye and graduated from Portsmouth High School and then spent four years serving with the United States Coast Guard in the Philippines, Portsmouth and Maine.

At a very young age he was introduced to Rye Harbor by his dad and spent many years on the docks and fishing. In addition to being a fisherman, he also was employed as a mechanic and more recently as a mechanic for the Town of Rye.

When not working, Skip could be found in his shop working on his Harley or his latest car or hot rod.

Family members include his sister, Sharon A. Good of Rye, his cherished niece, Heather L. Good and her companion Gary Godtland, Jr., of Kittery, ME, three uncles and aunts, Thomas F. and Sylvia Melican of Hampton, Carl S. and Mary Bragg of Newburyport, Mass., Douglas and Helene Fowler of

He was predeceased by his brother, Scotty William Gaucher who died in 1955.
