



## Kimberly J. Truchon

May 30, 1961 - July 31, 2016

Seabrook- Kimberly J. Truchon, 55, of Seabrook, and a former longtime resident of Hampton, passed away peacefully at her home on Sunday, July 31, 2016.

She was born in Franklin, NH, May 30, 1961, a daughter of Richard P. and Lorraine A. (Elliott) Truchon of Hampton.

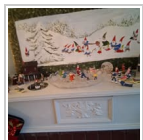

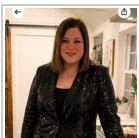
