



## Larry G Schrempf

Seabrook – Larry G. Schrempf, 64, of Seabrook, died peacefully Sunday, March 6, 2016 at Anna Jaques Hospital, Newburyport.

He was born December 24, 1951 in Newburyport, MA a son of the late Harold Schrempf and Velma (Hawkes) Huff.

Raised in Newburyport he attended Newburyport High School before leaving and starting his career at Sylvania. After only working a few years he enlisted in the United States Army, where he proudly served four years. After his time in the Army he returned home and resumed working at Sylvania, where he spent the next 20 years. He later worked for the Seabrook School District starting as a custodian and retiring as the Maintenance supervisor in 2011.

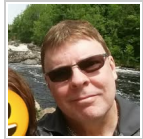
