Rye – Laurie Anne Snyder, 53, of Rye passed away peacefully at her home on Monday, November 9, 2020 after a short but courageous fight with cancer. She was born on March 27, 1967 in Manchester, NH, the only daughter of Laurier J. Spenard of Portsmouth and the late Nancy L. (Madden) Spenard who predeceased Laurie in August of this year.

Laurie was raised in Manchester and graduated from Trinity High School in 1985. Caring for others was always important to Laurie; she worked in healthcare her entire adult life. As a Physical Therapy assistant Laurie has served patients all over the seacoast area, including those at the Edgewood Centre, Langdon Place, and Webster at Rye.

Not one to sit idle, Laurie claimed to live a “Fast, Dark, and Dangerous” lifestyle.
