Seabrook – Lawrence T. “Larry” Small, 73, of Seabrook, died Tuesday, February 11, 2014 at Exeter Hospital after a sudden illness.

He was born November 2, 1940 in Beverly, Mass., a son of the late John F. and Eunice M. (Dutcher) Small.

After graduating from high school Mr. Small served proudly in the US Navy from 1959-1962. He was employed as a machinist and welder for Beverly Pattern in Beverly for 38 years retiring in 2002. He then worked part time for J & C Industries in Seabrook until 2007.

He made his home in Seabrook since 1971 coming from Gloucester, Mass. He was a member of the Hamilton, Mass American Legion Post 0194, enjoyed photography, gardening, hunting, fishing and traveling.

He leaves his fiancé, Barbara Jones of Seabrook, his son, Thomas L. Small and wife Jeanette of Sandown, his daughter, Lorrie A. O’Brien and husband Danny of Lakewood, WA, three grandchildren, Kaitlyn and Kyle O’Brien and Kennett Colby, his sister, Susan Small, nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents he was predeceased by his brother, John F. Small, Jr., and his sister Katherine Silverio.

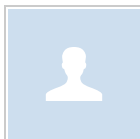
