Hampton – Lawrence S. Trinceri, 81, of Hampton, formerly of Southamptn, MA, peacefully passed away on Tuesday, August 13, 2024.

He was born on December 16, 1942, in Westfield, MA, the son of the late Lawrence J. and Emielia (Rzonca) Trinceri. Raised in Westfield, he graduated from Trade High School in Springfield, MA and later American International College where he played hockey and met his future wife of 50 years, the late Joan (Boduch) Trinceri.

A lifelong educator, he worked his entire career as a teacher and later a guidance counselor for the Easthampton Public Schools for 38 years, retiring in 2004.

Known to his family and friends as Butch or Larry, he was a family man first and foremost. His family meant the world to him, and he never missed a chance to watch any event featuring a member of his large extended family. Hockey was in his blood, from playing in his younger years and refereeing later in life, he was instrumental in establishing the hockey program at Easthampton High School. In retirement he enjoyed doting on his 2 grandchildren, spending time with family and friends and photography - especially flowers.
