



## Leland S. Bugbee

December 15, 1938 - December 27, 2016

Hampton – Leland S. Bugbee, 78, of Hampton and New Bern, NC, died peacefully on Tuesday, December 27, 2016 after a long battle with pneumonia.

He was born on December 15, 1938 in Newport, NH; son of the late Carl Bugbee and Helen Truell.

Raised and attended school in Newport, and later graduated College at Husson College with a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting.

Lee went on to complete a 20 year career in the United States Coast Guard and later worked for the Maine State Police as a communication officer, retiring after 28 years.

He was a hard working family man and an old fashion gentleman, who enjoyed reading sci-fi novels and watching his favorite hockey team, the Boston Bruins.

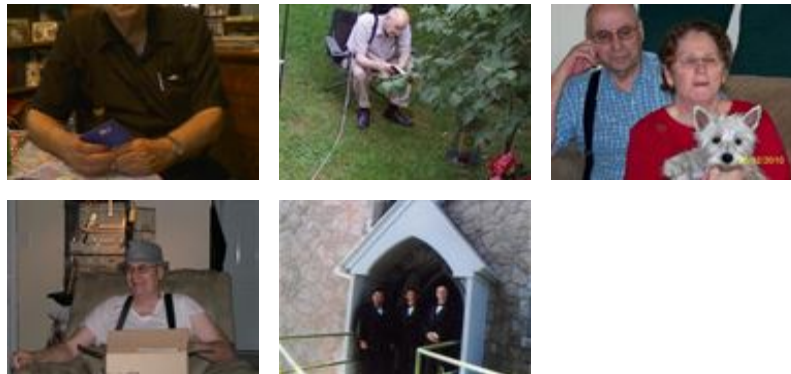
