



## Leo F. Harrison, DDS

June 20, 1924 - February 28, 2015

Rye – Dr. Leo F. Harrison, 90, of Rye, passed away peacefully at home on Saturday, February 28, 2015 with beloved family at his bedside.

Dr. Harrison was born in Concord on June 20, 1924, a son of the late Thomas M. and Adelaide M. (Beaulieu) Harrison.

Leo was a graduate of St. John's High School in Concord. He went on to attend St. Anselm College and graduated from the St. Louis University School of Dentistry. Dr. Harrison practiced in Portsmouth for over 30 years. He enjoyed lobstering and operated out of Rye Harbor for many years. He was a veteran of the Army Air Corps during WWII and was a member of the Southeast Dental Society, serving as their president in 1966.
