Hampton- Levi Ammon Kishbaugh, 84 yo, of Hampton, NH died at home surrounded by family on April 23, 2025.

Levi grew up in Nescopeck, PA. He attended Penn State Hazleton campus, and graduated from Bloomsburg University. He had a long career as an independent insurance adjuster, and owned Gillis and Associates in Manchester, NH. Levi will be most remembered as an avid gardener and lover of nature. It was a year round passion for him, including planning all winter, seedlings in the spring, gardening all summer and canning in the fall. He also leaves behind two sisters, Fayann Kishbaugh and Edna Kishbaugh.

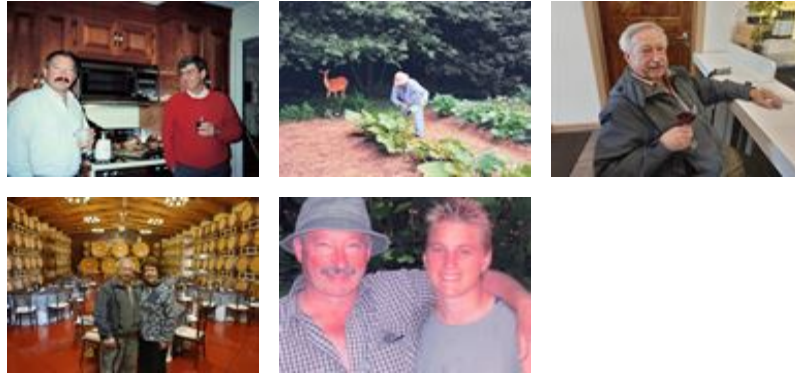
