Laconia – Linda J. Daigle, 66, of Laconia, passed away peacefully with her family by her side on Tuesday, July 26, 2022.

She was born April 11, 1956 in Stoneham, MA a daughter of the late Maurice J. and Mary (Hooper) Fama. Growing up in Stoneham, she graduated from Stoneham High School with the Class of 1974 and went on to receive her Bachelor's degree from UMass Lowell and her MBA degree from Southern New Hampshire University.

She married her high school sweetheart, her husband of 43 years, John Daigle. Together they lived in New York, Pennsylvania, and Londonderry where they raised their son Brian. Later, they moved to Lake Winnisquam, before settling on Lake Winnipesaukee in Laconia, NH.

She also loved traveling throughout Europe and the United States. She had a warmth, sense of humor and strength that will be

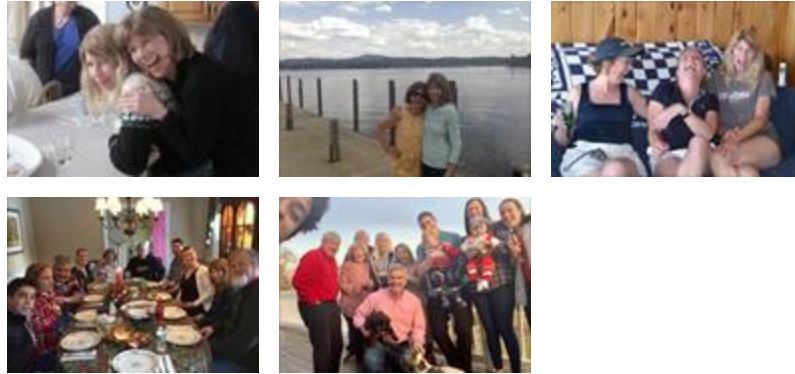
