October 21, 1961 - February 9, 2016

Peabody, MA – Linda M. Thidemann-Dubin, 54, of Peabody, formerly of the New Hampshire seacoast, died Tuesday, February 9, 2016 at her home after a sudden illness.

She was born October 21, 1961 in Winthrop, a daughter of Eric H. and Carol V. (Brown) Thidemann of Peabody.

Linda was raised and educated in Peabody and graduated from Peabody High School with the Class of 1979. She was also a graduate of the University of Massachusetts at Amherst in 1983.

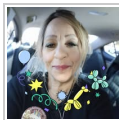
