Lois Dame Taylor, a longtime resident of Rye, passed away peacefully at Webster at Rye, on Saturday March 16, 2024. She was 95 years old.

Born in Exeter, NH on September 17, 1928, Lois was the daughter of the Late Charles O and Madeline (Chase) Smith. Raised and educated in Exeter, graduating from Robison Female Seminary in 1947.
