Seabrook – Louise Marie Taylor, 91, of Seabrook, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, August 25, 2020 at her home, surrounded by her loving and devoted family. Louise was born in Malden, MA on January 2, 1929, a daughter of the late Samuel E. and Elizabeth (MacDonald) Mullett.

Louise was raised in Malden and graduated from Malden High School with the Class of 1946. She worked as a legal secretary, office manager and bookkeeper and in her early twenties moved to California to live with her aunt. While in California, she met her former husband and father of her children, the late Robert L. Taylor. Louise and Robert were married in 1955 and after a brief time living in San Diego, returned to Malden. Louise moved to Seabrook in 1968 and was a faithful communicant of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal Church in Hampton. She served with the Stephen Ministry at the church bringing sunshine to the lives of the sick, shut-ins and anyone in need. Louise was also an active volunteer with Seacoast Birthright of Portsmouth.

She loved to read, travel, line dance and play cards but Louise's happiest times were with family. Her primary focus was always caring for her family as she successfully raised seven children.

She is survived by her seven children; Karen E. Taylor of Portsmouth, Ann Walsh and her husband John of Milton, Robert Taylor of Somersworth, Judy

Taylor of Seabrook, Matthew Taylor of Hampton, John Taylor of Milton, and Nancy Ohlenbusch and her husband Eric of Milton. She also leaves her sister, Barbara McMahon of Melrose, MA and her 10 grandchildren, 11 great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents, Louise was predeceased by her brother, Donald Mullett and her sister, Alma Dolan.
