She was born on July 1, 1947 in Denver, CO, a daughter of the late Charles and Lillian (Bacher) Simonsen.

Luanna was raised in Denver and had made her home in Portland, OR for many years. It was while living in Portland that she met her future husband, the late Arthur C. Waldron.
