



## Lucille J. Finochiaro

February 6, 1933 - November 13, 2021

Hampton – Lucille J. Finochiaro, 88, of Hampton, formerly of Methuen, MA passed away peacefully on Saturday, November 13, 2021, with her loving daughter at her side.

She was born in New York City, NY on February 6, 1933, a daughter of the late Louis Grieco and Gertrude (MacDonald) Grieco.

Raised in Lawrence, MA, she graduated from Lawrence High School with the Class of 1950 where she met the love of her life and husband of 50 years, the late Joseph Finochiaro. She went on to Fazio's Beauty School to receive her license in Cosmetology. She worked as a renowned Cosmetologist in several salons in the Merrimack Valley including her own business, Coiffures by Lucille. Following many years as an exceptional beautician, Lucille went on to receive her Associates Degree and teaching certificate from Fitchburg State.

Lucille enjoyed 30 years of teaching at the Greater Lawrence Regional Technical High School becoming the head of the Cosmetology Department and serving on the Massachusetts State Board of Barbering, Cosmetology and Esthetics before her retirement. She also spent many summers working alongside her daughter "Mia" at Ashworth Hair Designs.

A faith-filled and loving wife, mother and grandmother, Lucille always made

everyone around her feel special. Her generous and thoughtful way touched all who knew her. Family was everything to her and she enjoyed every moment spent together. She loved spending summers at Salisbury and Hampton Beach, socializing, dancing, music and travel.
